Brodie and Flynn (11-1/2 and 4 – still love their walk at 5AM with Paul, both are well-loved, nicknames Chubbs and Flindar)

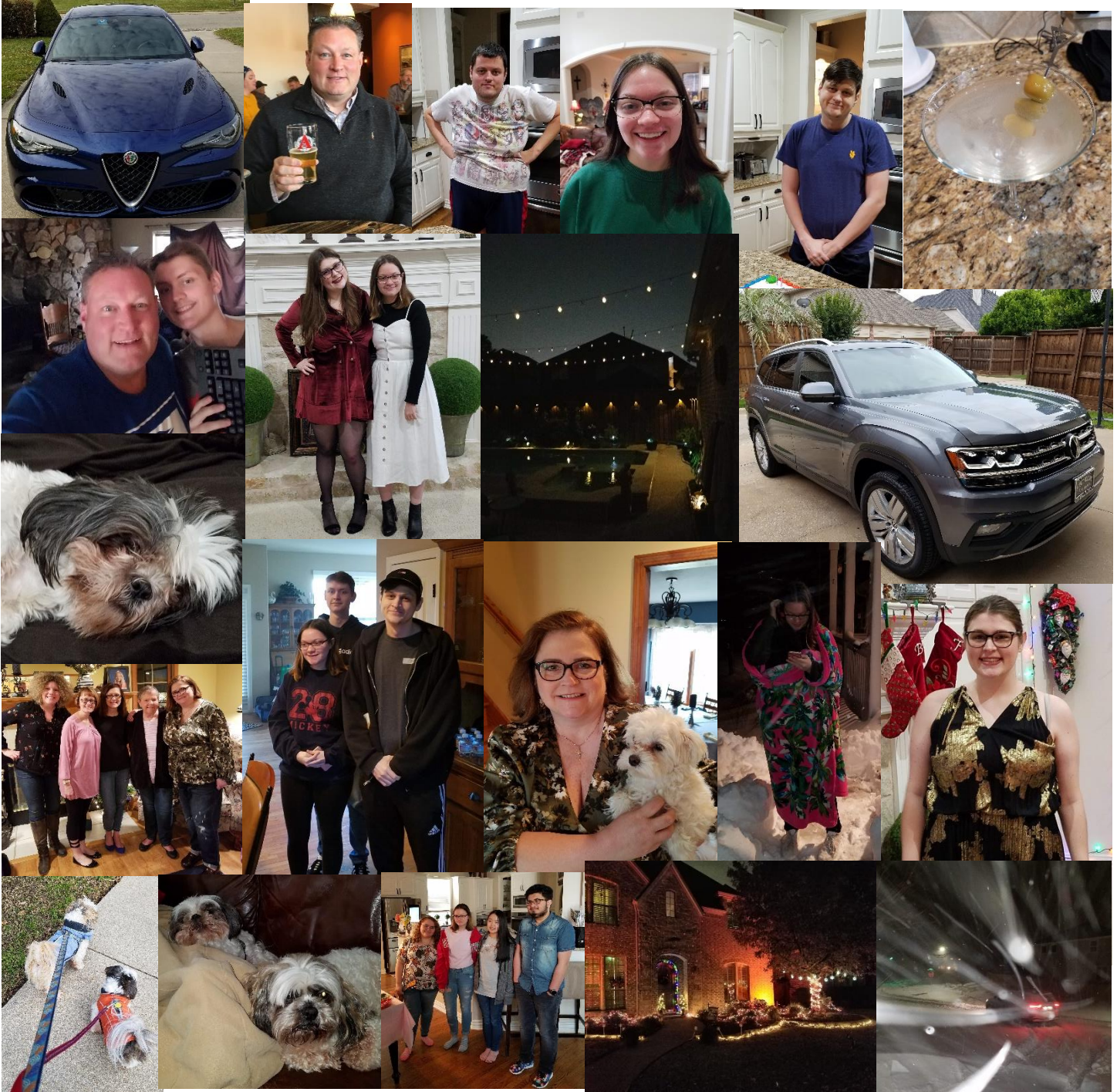
