Brodie and Flynn (walking in the mornings at 5AM with Paul, still spoiled and loved dearly)

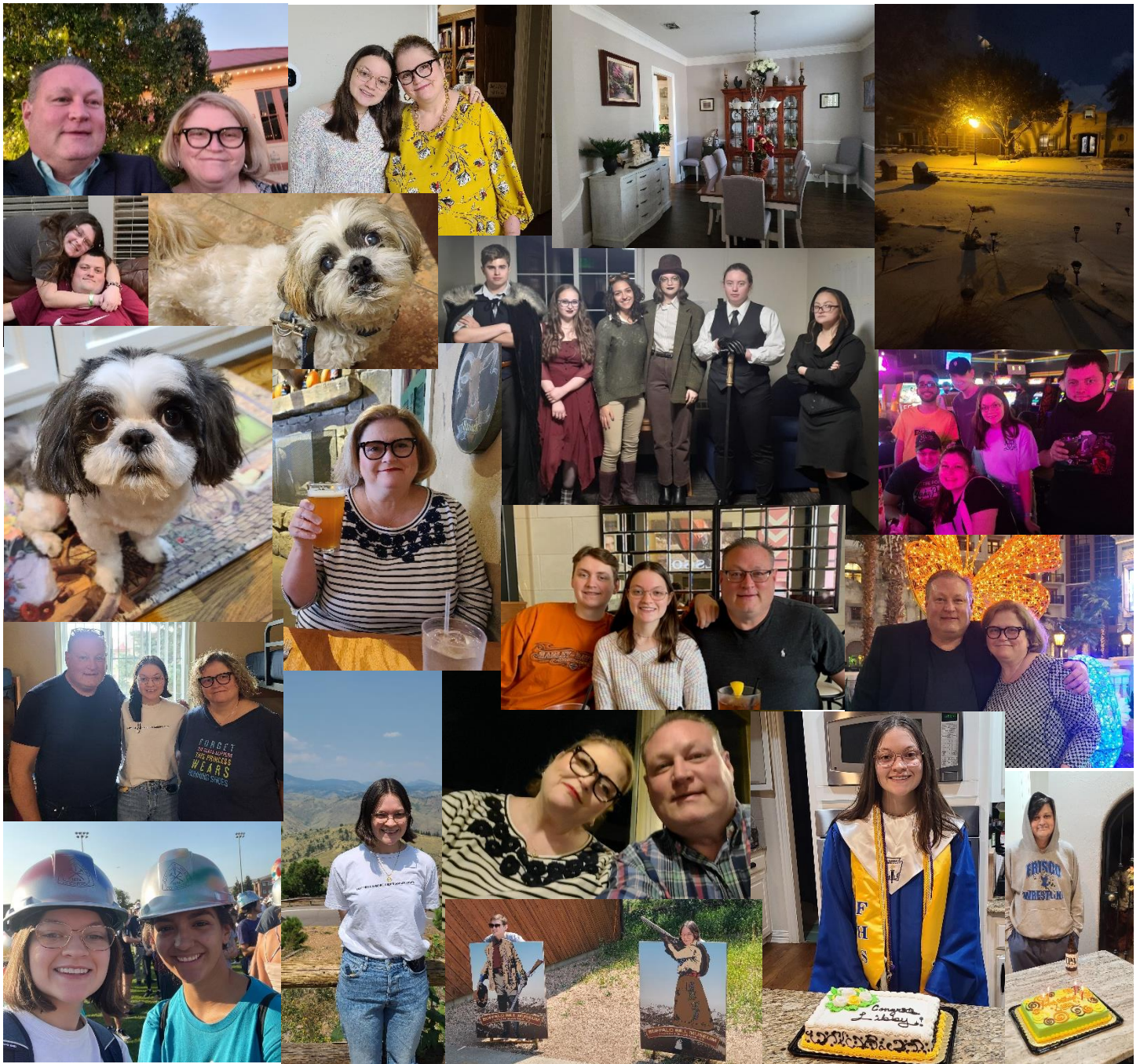
